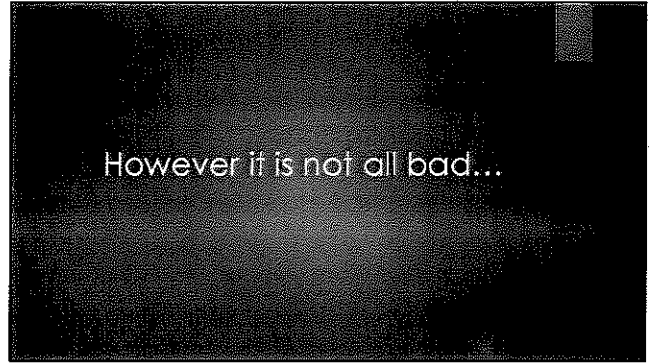
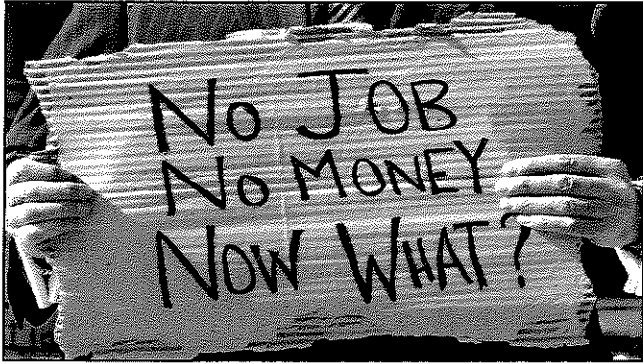






Because of all this terrible treatment from the Europeans and Canadians, First nations have to deal with poverty and terrible living conditions.
